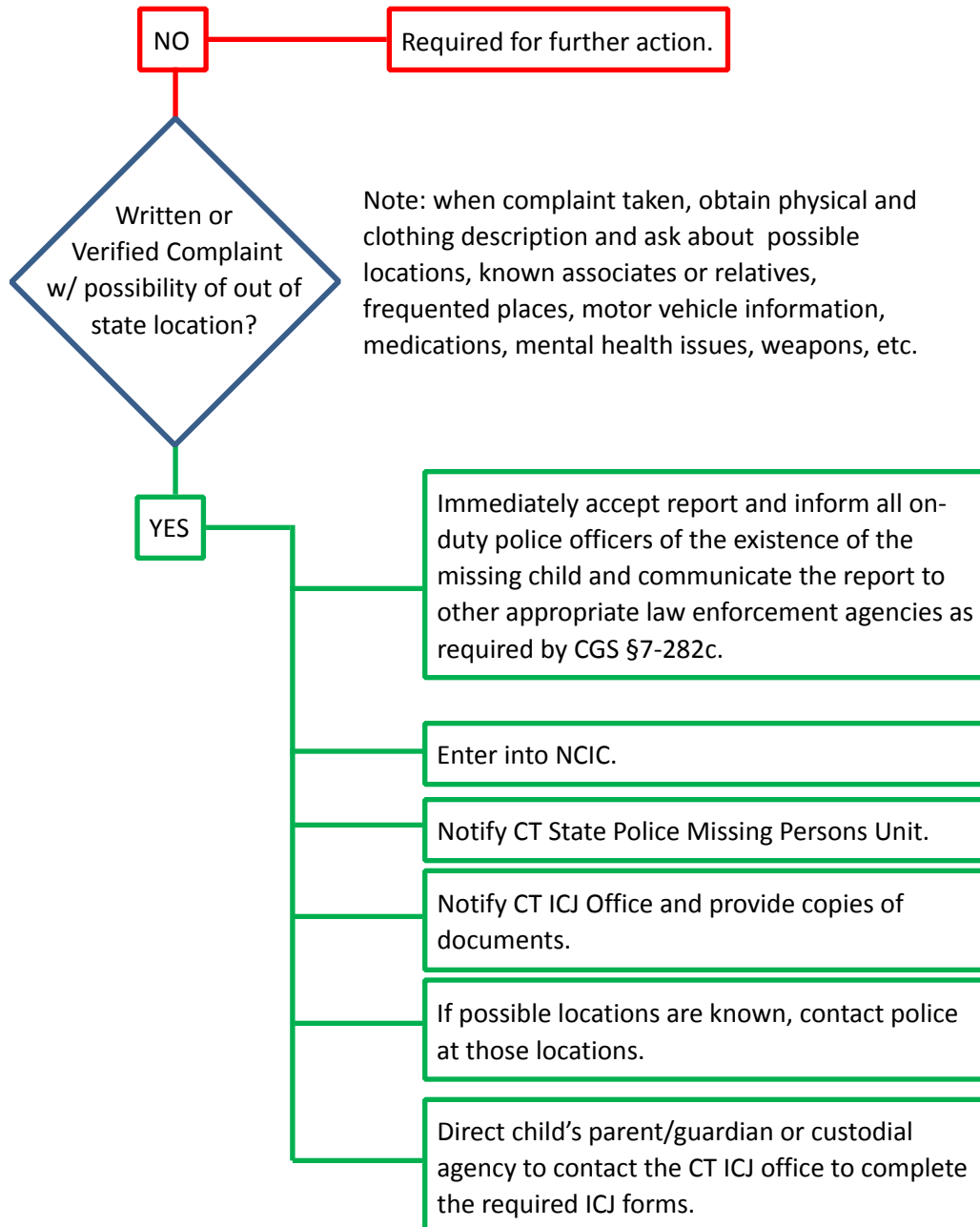
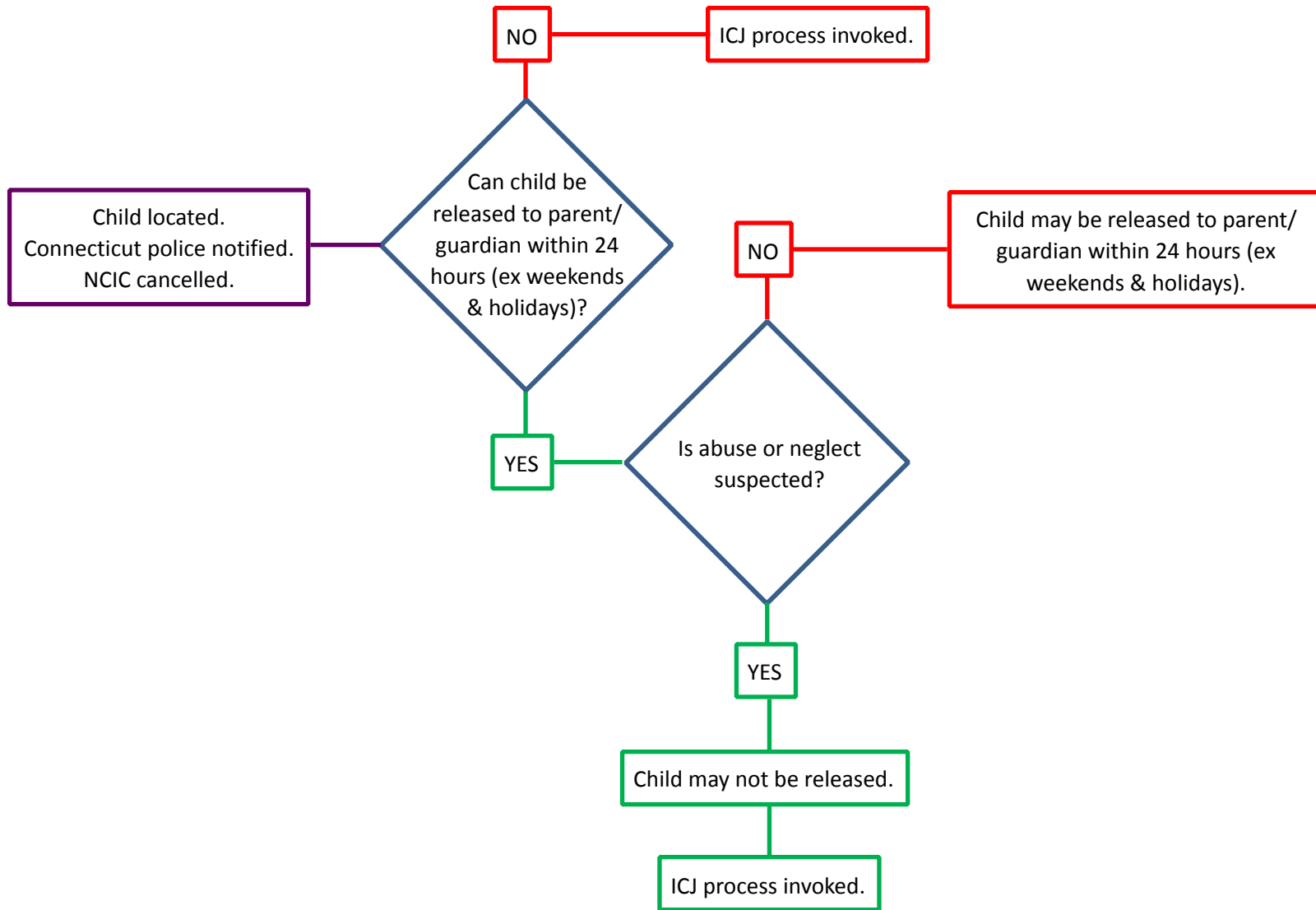

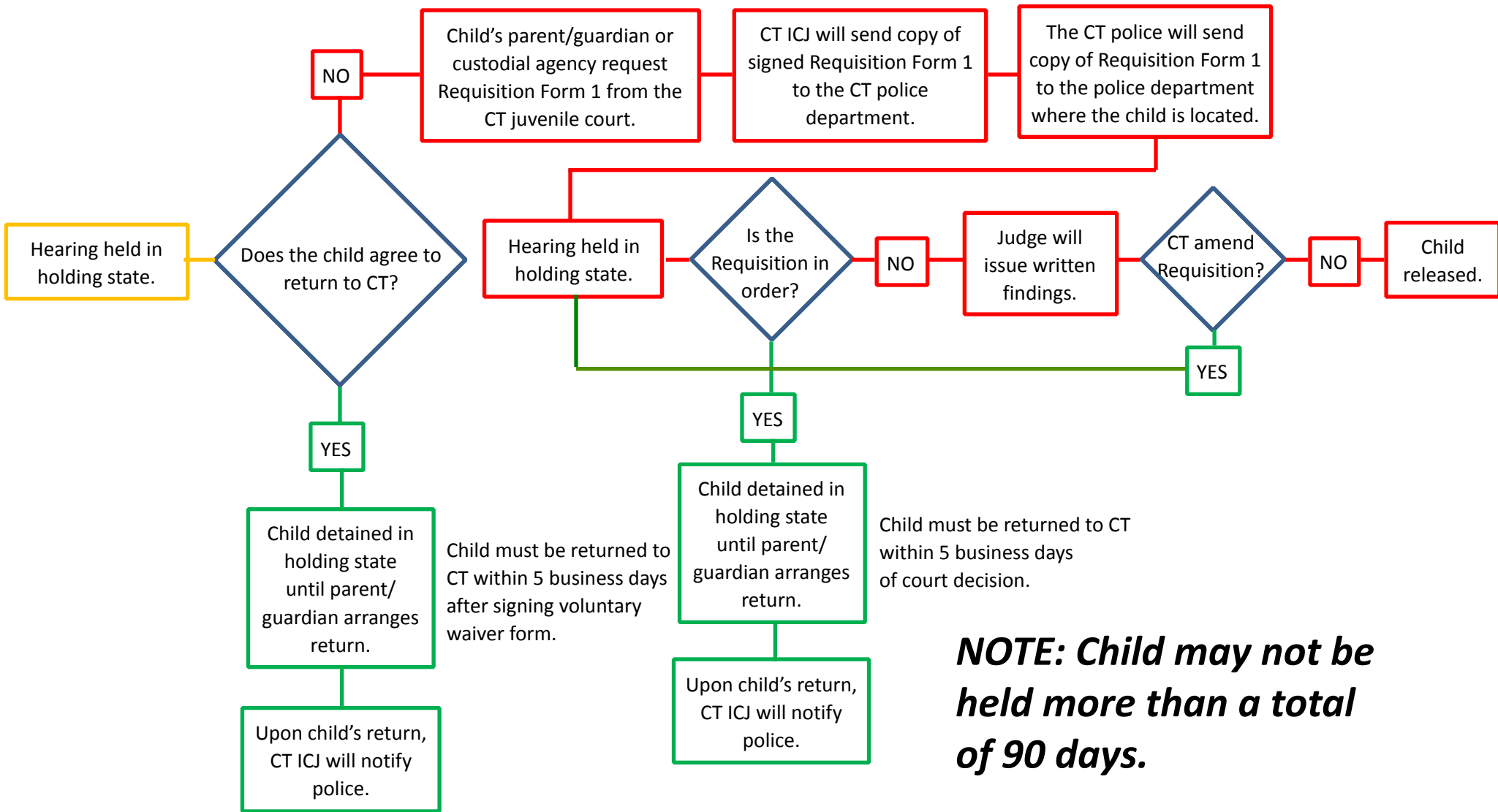


Non-delinquent Connecticut child runs away out of state – Child is located

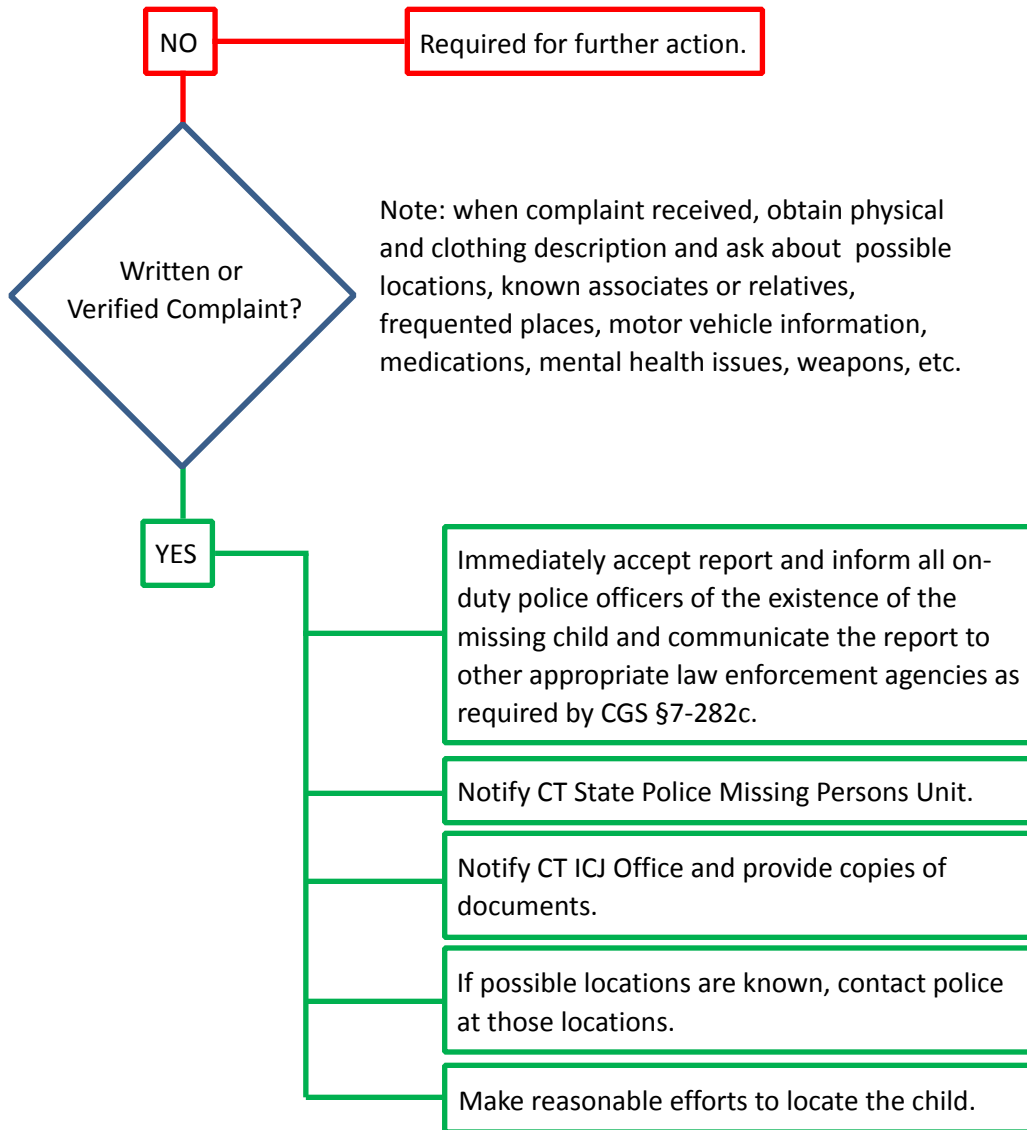


Non-delinquent Connecticut child runs away out of state – Child is located

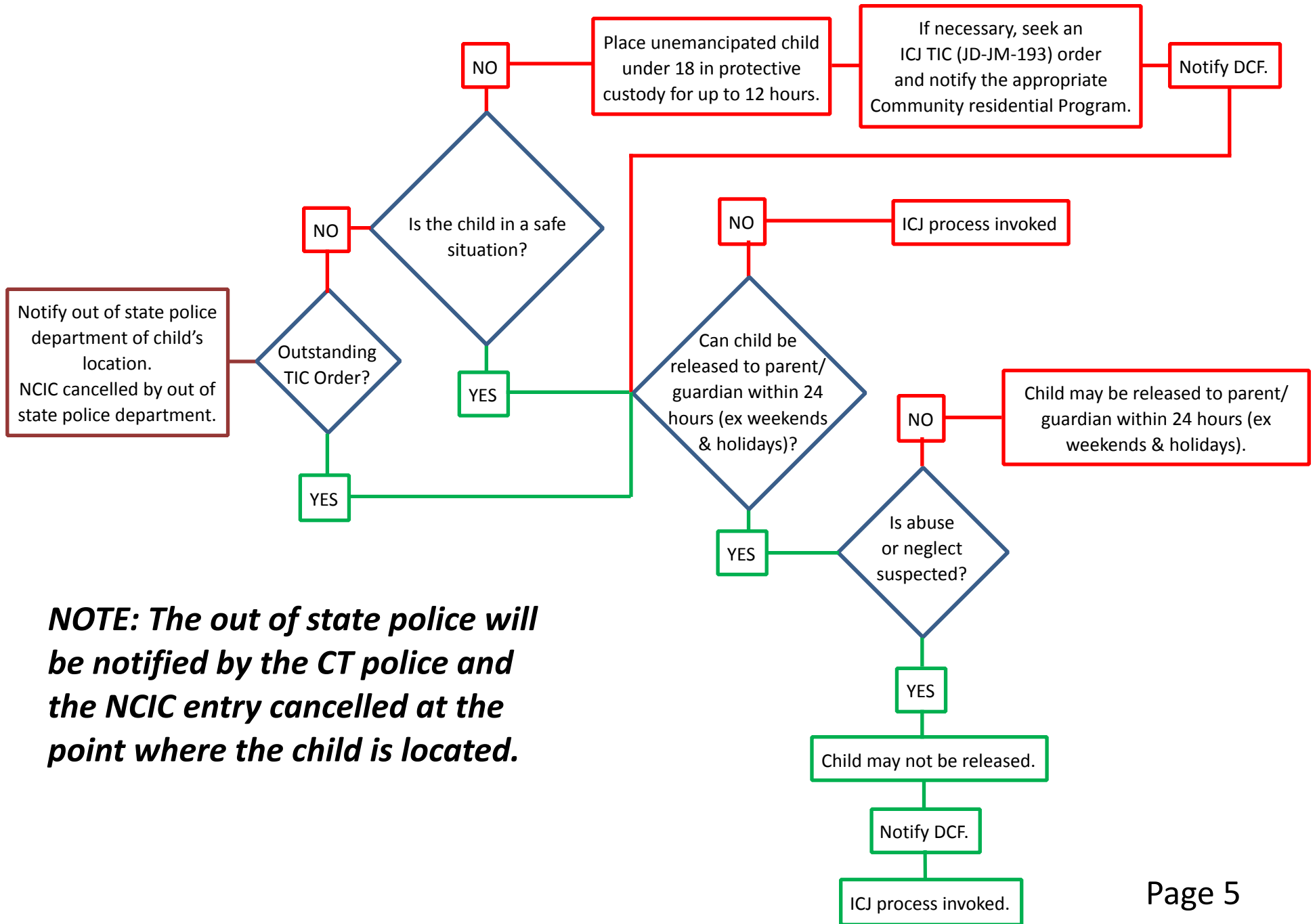
ICJ Process Invoked



Non-delinquent out of state child in Connecticut – Complaint received



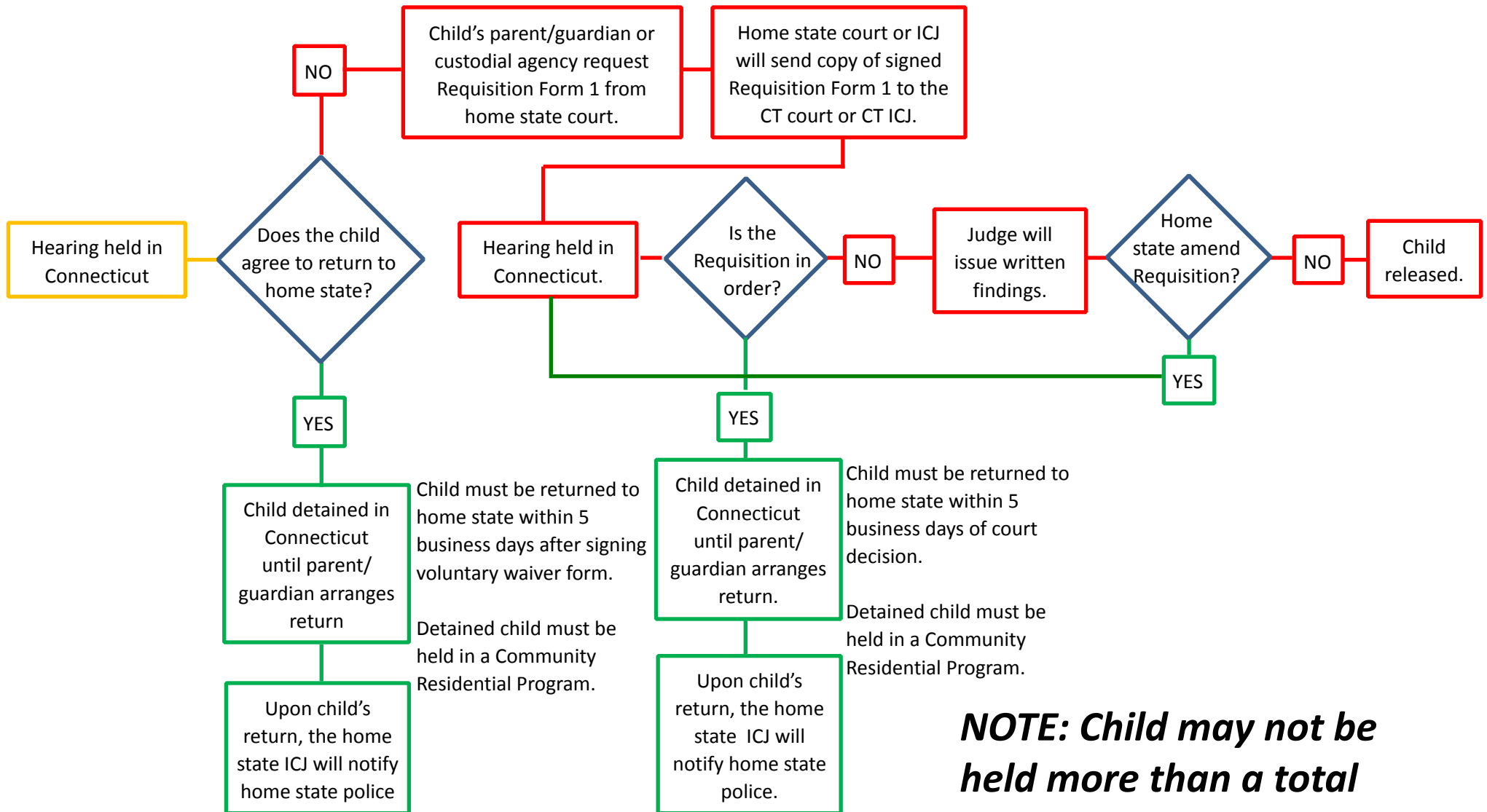
Non-delinquent out of state child in Connecticut – Child is located



NOTE: The out of state police will be notified by the CT police and the NCIC entry cancelled at the point where the child is located.

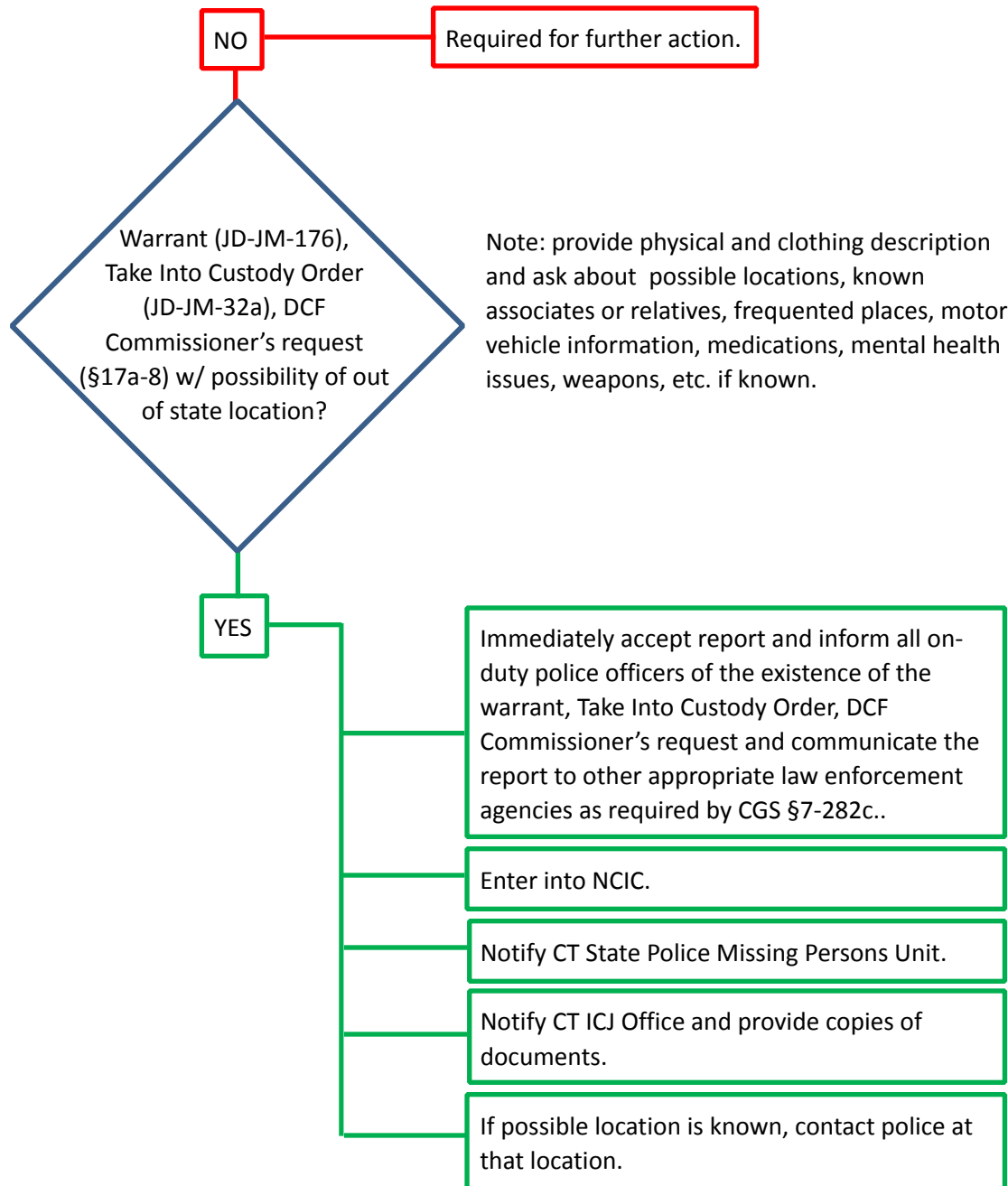
Non-delinquent out of state child in Connecticut – Child is located

ICJ Process Invoked

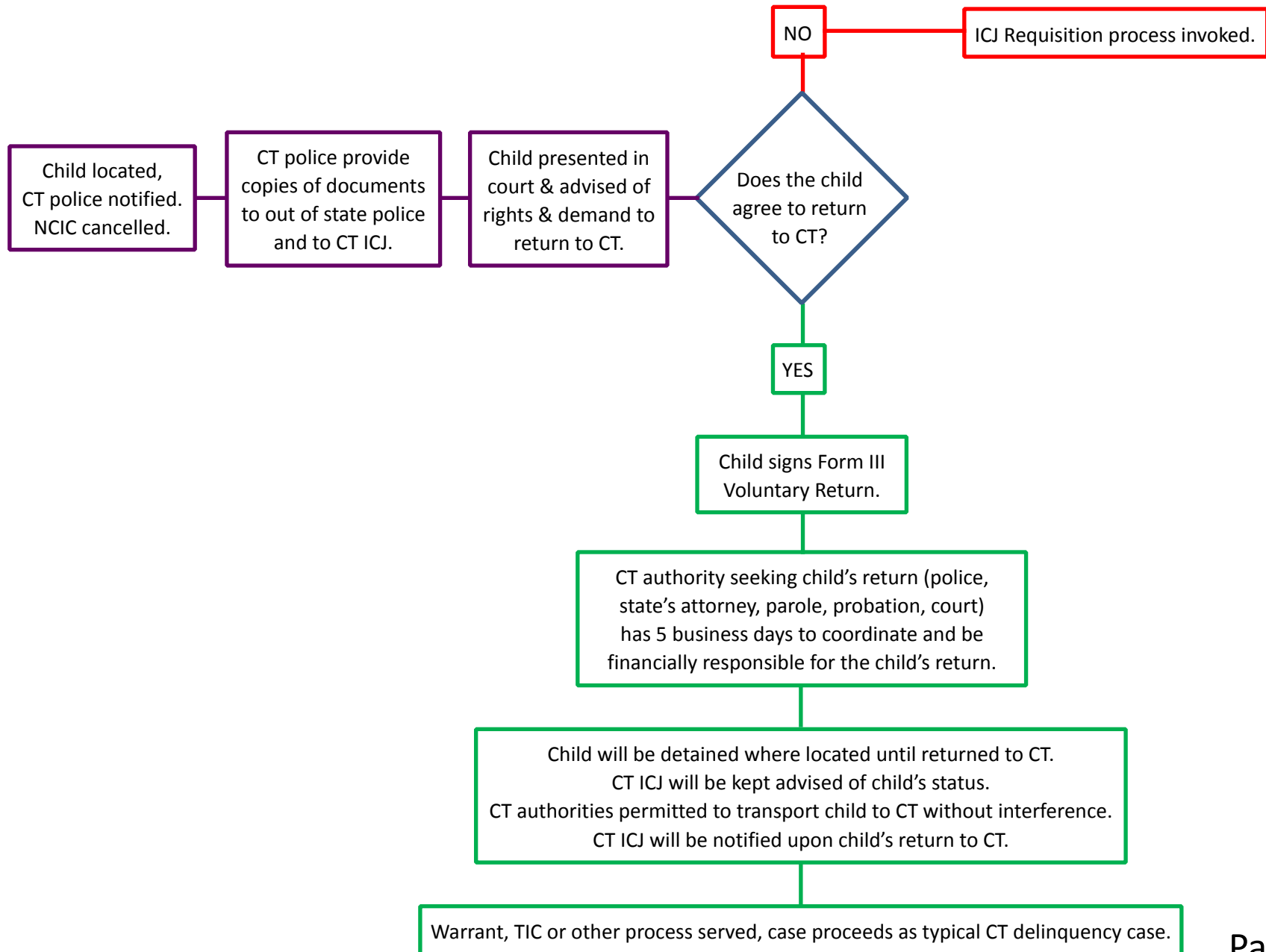


NOTE: Child may not be held more than a total of 90 days.

ICJ Requisition Process Invoked – Connecticut process

CT authority seeking child's return (police, state's attorney, parole, probation, court) applies to CT court for a Requisition Form II and a warrant or Take Into Custody order (JD-JM-192), if one has not already been issued.

Must be done within 60 days of notification of child's refusal to return if the child is already in custody.

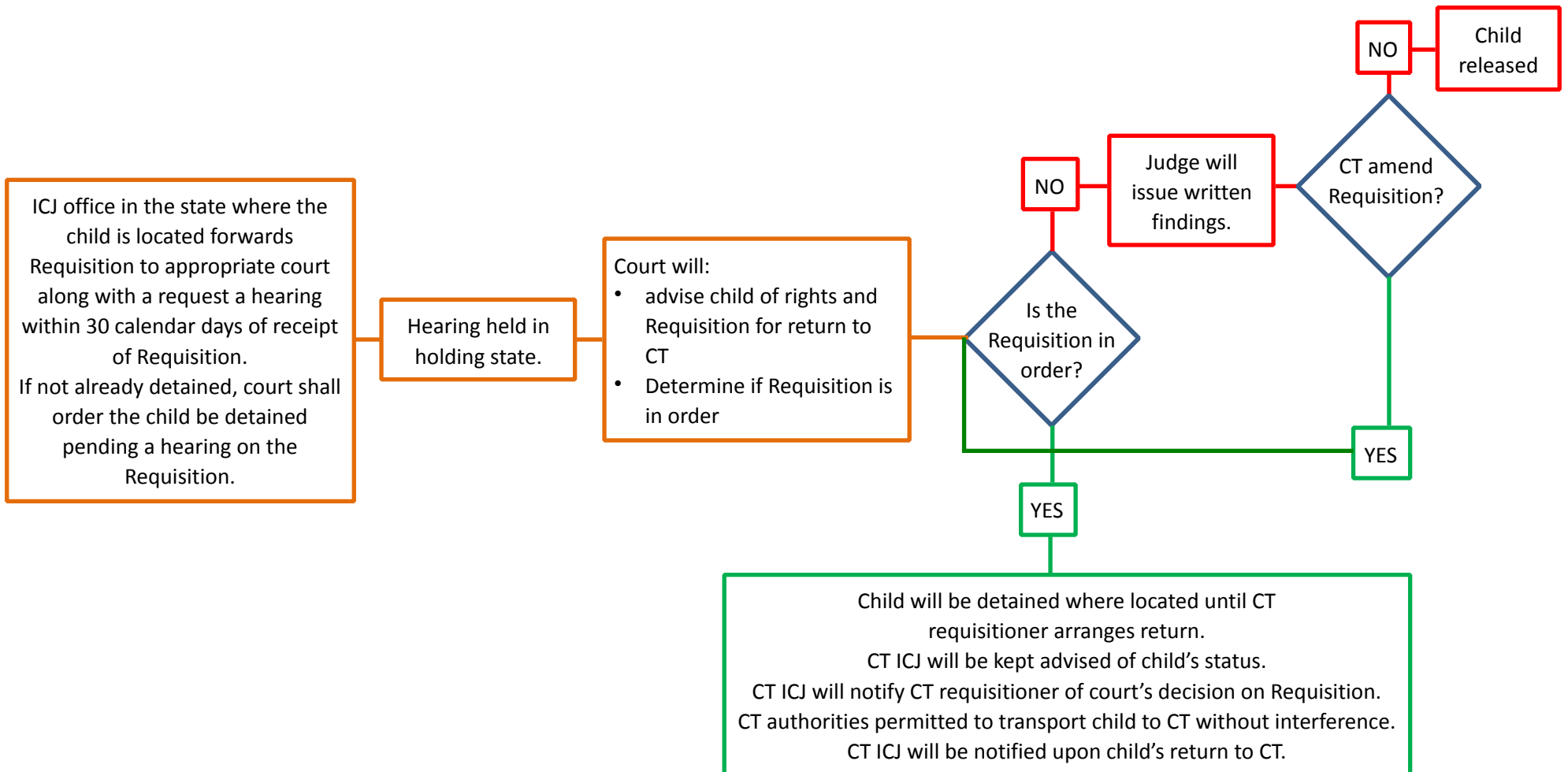
CT authority sends to CT ICJ office two certified copies of:

- The signed Form II
- All supporting affidavits & documents authorizing custody including:
 - Warrant (JD-JM-176)
 - Arrest reports
 - Take Into Custody Order (JD-JM-32a)
 - Proof of adjudication
 - Dispositional Order
 - DCF Commissioner's Request (17a-8)
 - Delinquency Petition
 - Other affidavits & documents

CT ICJ sends complete package to ICJ office in state where child is located and awaits outcome of out of state court decision on Requisition.

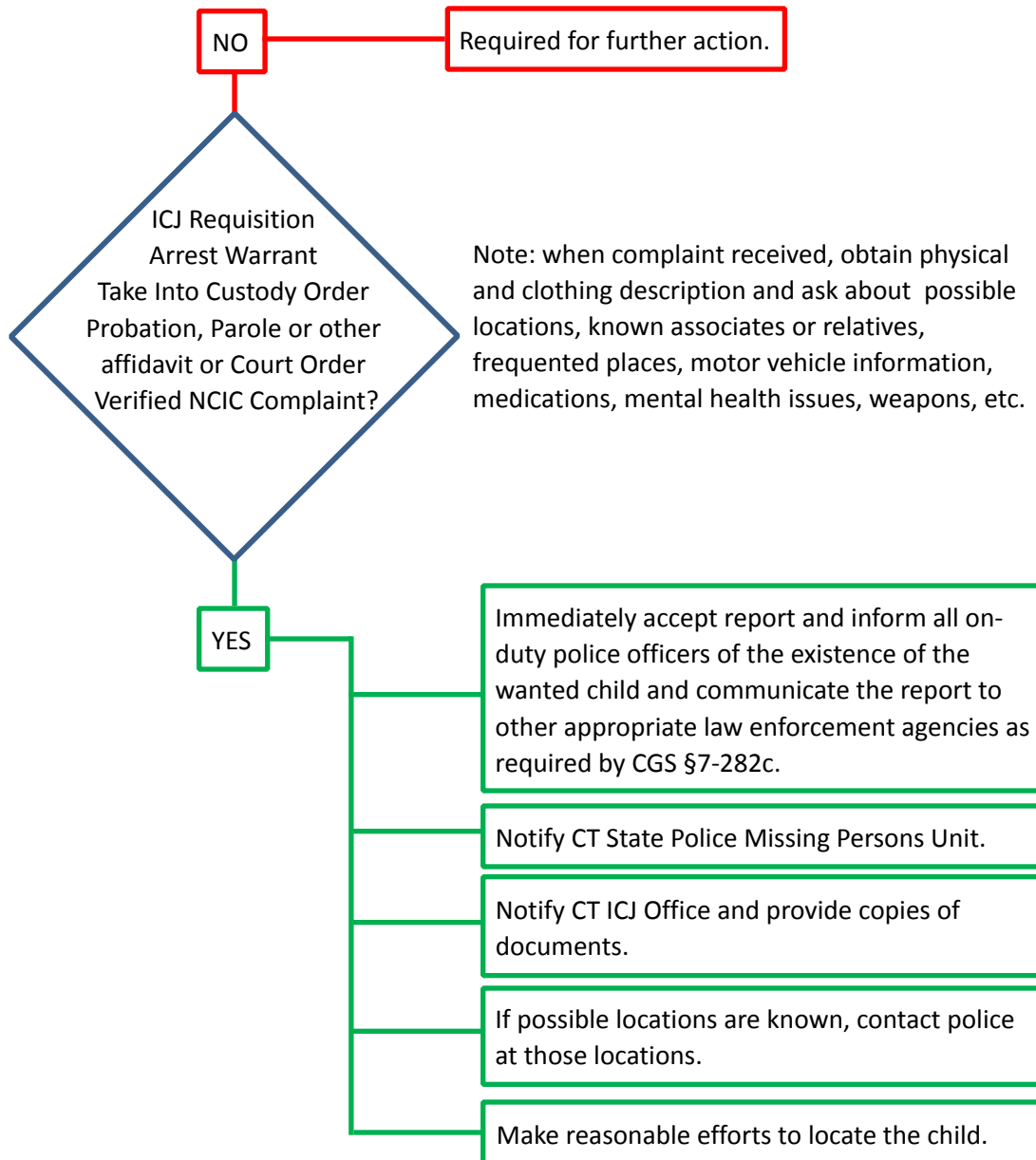
Delinquent Connecticut child runs away out of state – Child is located & refuses to return

ICJ Requisition Process Invoked – State where child is located process

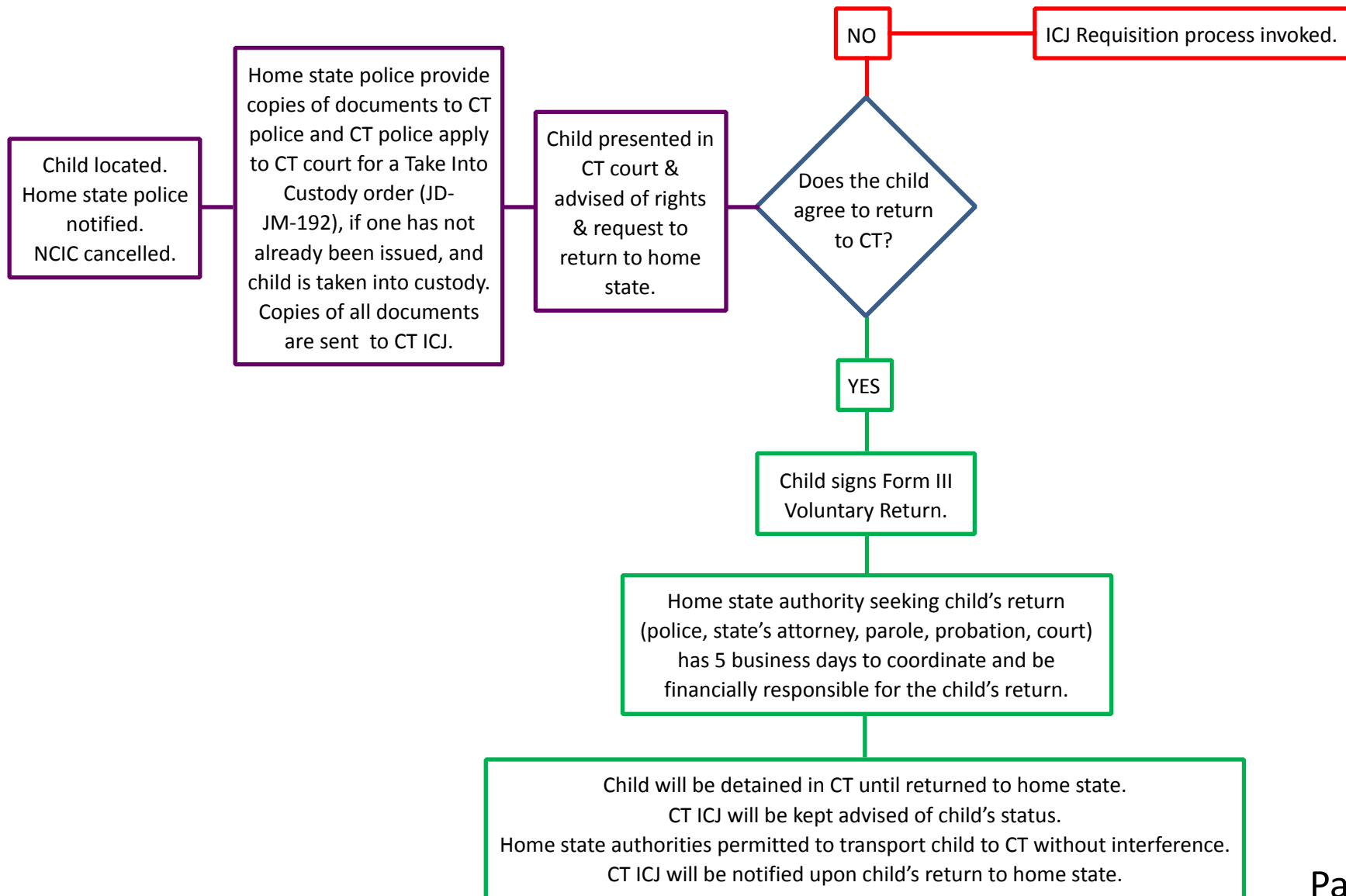


Child must be returned to home state within 5 business days of court decision.

Delinquent out of state child in Connecticut – Complaint Received

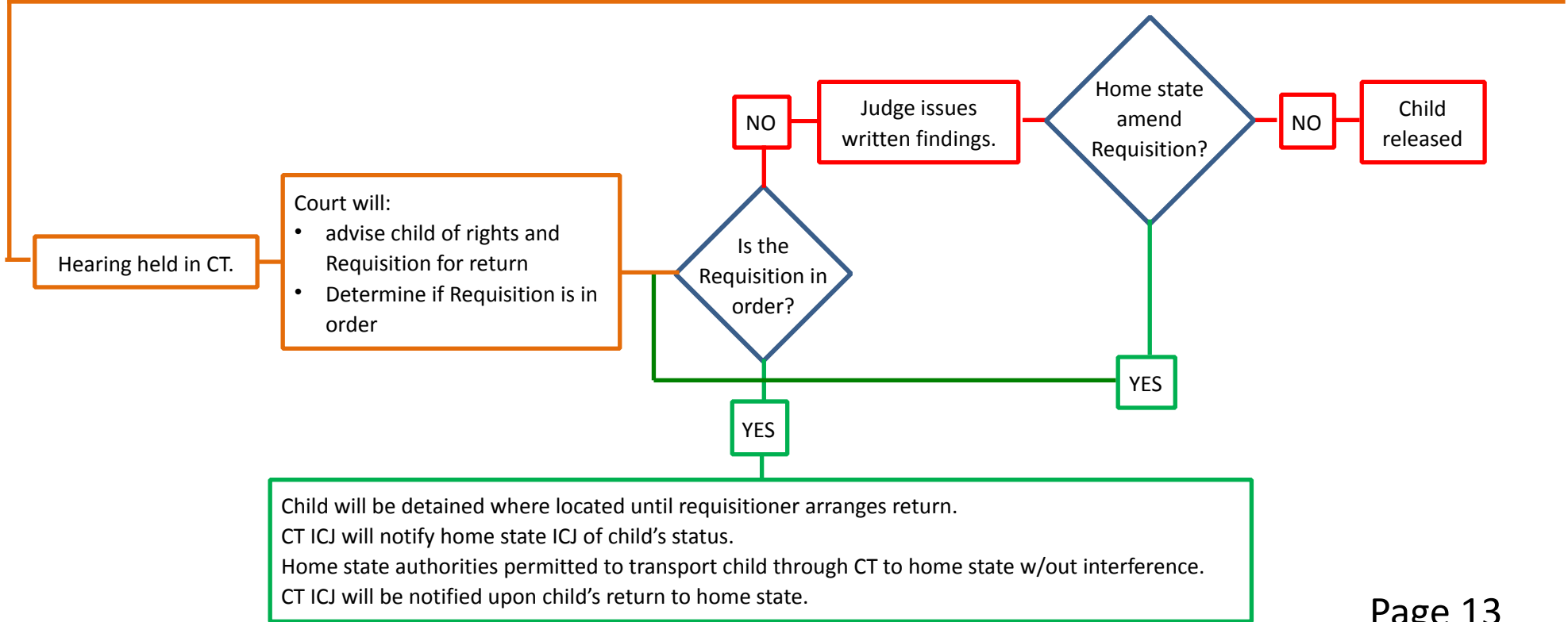
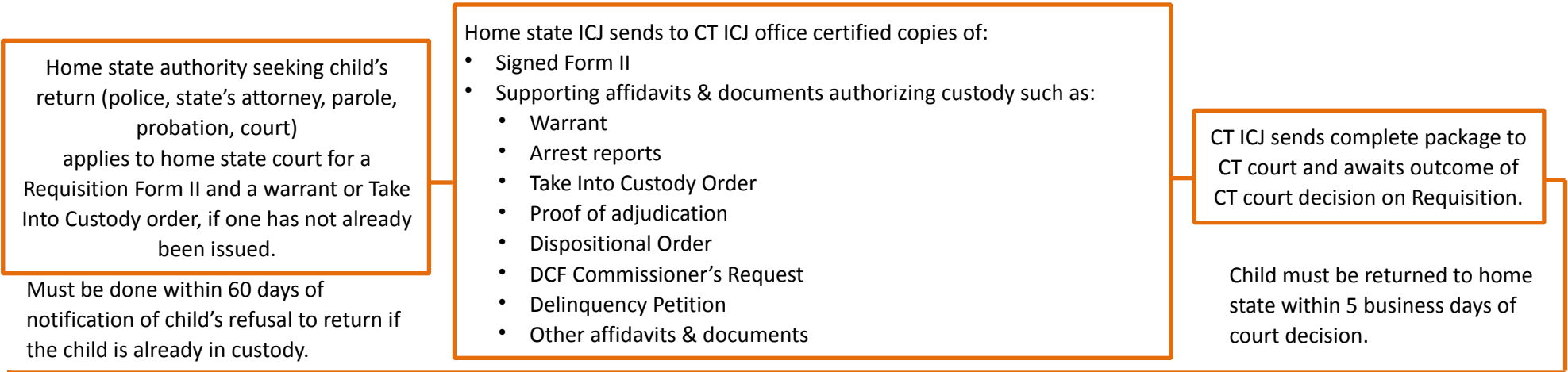


Delinquent out of state child in Connecticut – Child is located & agrees to return
