

Delinquency Cases

Effective 7/1/12, a 16 or 17 year old will be handled as:

A Juvenile

if they violate:

any federal criminal law;

a state law other than:

- * a violation, except possession of <1/2 ounce of marijuana;
- * an infraction, except possession of paraphernalia for use with <1/2 ounce of marijuana;
- * a Title 14 MV offense;
- * failure to pay or plead; or
- * FTA in an adult court case;

a condition of **juvenile** probation;

a **juvenile delinquency** court order;

FTA for a **juvenile** court hearing;

An Adult

if they violate:

a local or municipal ordinance;

a state law that is:

- * a violation, except possession of <1/2 ounce of marijuana;
- * an infraction, except possession of paraphernalia for use with <1/2 ounce of marijuana;
- * a Title 14 MV offense;
- * failure to pay or plead; or
- * FTA in an **adult** court case;

a condition of **adult** probation;

an **adult** court order;
